Starting point



 Guidance should be helpful – if you follow it you should be on the safe side.

Therefore:

- 2. Guidance needs to be acceptable and workable for all stakeholders that
 - prepare dossiers (Industry, MSCA, ECHA)
 - assess dossiers (MSCA, ECHA-staff/C'ttees)
 - enforce REACH (enforcement authorities)

Guidance



- Shall be helpful but is not law
- As long as you are within REACH, you may deviate from the guidance – but -
- Guidance shows you the safe way to implementing REACH
- because the important players agreed
 - they participated in the development of the guidance
 - and have accepted the text

Navigator tool




Use it to

 - allows to use IUCLID data
- ECHA web-site on pre-registration: 4/'08
 - goes life these days
- REACH-IT for (pre-)registration: 05/'08
 - will become available in May
- Translation to make guidance more accessible
